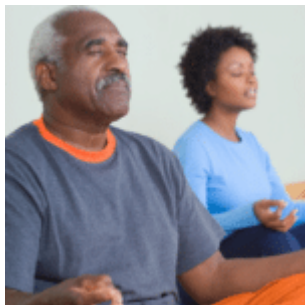
You'll be able to shop and use your monthly credit right away!

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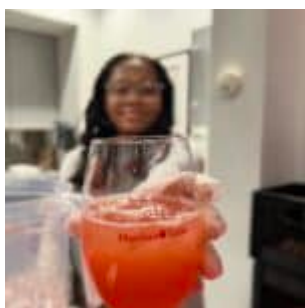
