


Dear Friend,

Growing Up Strong


In early September, our two nationally accredited early education centers bustled with laughter and excitement as young learners made their way into their classrooms to start the new school year. While we provide the best-possible learning environment *inside* the classroom for children from six weeks to four years, we are also doubling down on our efforts to support children *outside* the classroom.

Your generosity has helped to fund DC College Savings Plan 529 accounts for young children in the District. With an initial investment of \$1,000 from Martha's Table and the opportunity for parents to contribute additional funds, these accounts will help families save for education for their children—whether it be college, an apprenticeship, or vocational training. Through an investment option of the family's choice, the accounts will grow for at least 14 years and be ready to access when their child transitions to higher education.



Recently, one of our neighbors, Ms. Charlene, shared exactly what your support of these child savings accounts means for her community:

"Long-term, that will be a substantial amount of money and will help a child go to college or career training. It will help them step into a career. Children are the future, and if we don't focus on our young people, what kind of future will we have?"



Strong and Healthy, *Together*

With your continued partnership, over the next four years, we will deliver on our commitment to *double* the reach of our healthy grocery distribution, connecting more neighbors than ever before to fresh and healthy food. We are proud to do so while honoring the dignity and agency of each neighbor who visits our markets.

We are thrilled to share that this month—after more than two years of emergency food response necessitated by the pandemic—we are re-introducing a choice-based shopping experience for our guests. While pre-packed grocery bags will remain available for neighbors who are in a rush, guests visiting Martha's Table are now invited to shop—always at no cost—and select from a variety of





fruits, vegetables, household goods, and pantry items to bring home to their families.

Recently, one of our market guests, Ms. Brown, shared what this choice-based experience means to her. "I want my kids to learn about different produce and fruits," Ms. Brown explained. "The produce I am getting from Martha's Table helps me because I can keep more fresh fruit in the house for my kids to snack on. ...We tried some of the recipes and we actually like them! I'm so glad that we are able to try new produce we would never have tried before."

Strong Moms Mean Strong Families, Strong Futures

At Martha's Table, we are committed to standing with strong families across the District of Columbia. With your support, we are proud to deepen this commitment through *Strong Families, Strong Futures D.C.*, in partnership with the D.C. Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development. This direct cash assistance program equips new and expecting mothers in D.C. with financial and individualized support to help them navigate the pivotal first year of their child's life.

So far, more than 130 mothers have enrolled in the program and received over \$1.2 million in direct cash assistance. But our support doesn't stop there. Participating mothers are able to access the full suite of Martha's Table resources, including "Moms' Monday," an emotional wellness workshop for mothers; "Unfiltered Coffee and Conversation," an affinity and support group for new and expectant



mothers; and "Healthy Happy Hours," a chance for moms to invest in their own self-care and build healthy habits—all of which are weekly engagements.

At Martha's Table, we believe that when other mission-driven organizations in our community are strong, it increases their capacity to support our neighbors and to effect positive change. Unfortunately, many grassroots organizations who have served our neighbors in Southeast D.C.



for years are often overlooked for funding opportunities from traditional philanthropy partners. With your help, we're deepening our impact even further with the launch of our new Community Impact Fund.

When you support Martha's Table, you're also standing alongside neighborhood leaders who share the lived experiences of the communities they serve. Through the Community Impact Fund—and in partnership with the Greater Washington Community Foundation—we've made unrestricted grants of \$10,000 each to ten exceptional nonprofits that were selected independently by a council of Southeast D.C. residents based on their track record of community impact.

One inspirational grantee is the Anacostia AMP Outreach & Empowerment Center, which strives to provide community H.O.P.E. through healing, opportunity, provision, and empowerment. "This will be life changing for the people we serve," Aummett Paige, President of Anacostia AMP, reflected. "This grant provides a huge relief to the organization and allows us to expand our reach in the community."
